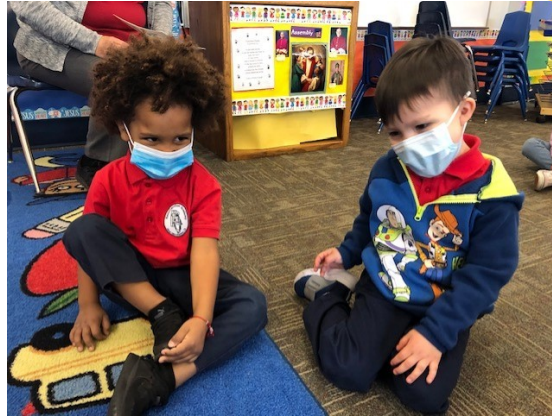


Resurrection Academy : working virtually
