

# Homily Reflection by Fr. Imo

## JESUS' RITUAL FOR FAILURE

Immediately John came back from work, he went straight to the North corner of his house, gazed very intently at the upper part of his fence, and started laughing. When asked what he went to the corner to do, he replied. "I know I cannot help having troubles in my job, but the last thing I will do is to go into my house with my daily troubles. That wall at the corner is my trouble shooter – the airy space there fills me with joy whenever I go there do breathing exercise, mumble some prayers and drop my worries."

Similarly, every day of our life has its own trouble. In the first reading, while doing his God assigned job, Amos met some resistance from Jeroboam, a corrupt leader and Amaziah, a high priest loyal to the king. Jeroboam regarded Amos as nothing more than a court prophet seeking to make a living by presuming to speak for God. Amos did not allow this false accusation to demoralize but shook it off his shoulder.

In today's Gospel, Jesus sent his disciples out on their first preaching practice to the villages. He thought it wise to provide them with a trouble resistant gesture as he said: "If any place will not welcome you or refuse to hear you, shake off the dust on your feet" (Mk 6:11). In other words, if you try to teach the people and meet a failure as a result of their opposition, do not let the failure get you down. Shake off the dust from that village, go to a new village and start again on a fresh page.

The fear of the outcome of our endeavors has always been a major thing preventing us from making some moves in life. Sometimes we dwell too long on past failures and allow them to rob our lives of enthusiasm and joy. At other times we allow the pressures of the workplace to ruin the peace of our family life. Similarly, one of the things that hinder the spread of the Gospel is not only the excuses of people about their lack of good knowledge of theology to preach but fear of rejection or what people are going to say.

In order to prevent excuse and fear, we need to brave our experiences, and learn how to shake off the dust of the troubles of the day. Shaking off the dust from the disciples' feet is their own way of hanging their problems on the past and not let the memory of ill-treatment come in the way of future success. This is done with the hope that tomorrow will bring with it a brand-new day with brand-new opportunities. In this case, it is like a game of football. Even if you lost 10-0 in yesterday's game, today is a whole new ball game and the scoreboard starts at 0-0.

The good news today is that failure is not the end of the world. We should expect it, and when it happens, we exercise Jesus' ritual for failure – "shake off the dust" and go on. What happens when we fail to shake off the dust of failures from our feet is that the dust accumulates and weighs us down. The result then is depression, withdrawal, boredom, anger, confusion, finger pointing, dismay and despair. When this happens, we quit instead of go on to a new city as the disciples were instructed or to a new project or new vision. But Jesus does not want us to be quitters. He wants us to begin again each new day with new opportunities and new zeal.

Already Jesus has provided us with a trouble shooter in himself. This is what Peter meant when he told believers: "Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you" (1 Peter 5:7). Let us, therefore, avail ourselves this divine therapy any time we meet with resistance or failure or rejection.

## EL RITUAL DEL FRACASO DE JESÚS

Inmediatamente Juan regresó del trabajo, se dirigió directamente a la esquina norte de su casa, miró con mucha atención la parte superior de su cerca y se echó a reír. Cuando se le preguntó a qué iba a la esquina, respondió. "Sé que no puedo evitar tener problemas en mi trabajo, pero lo último que haré es ir a mi casa con mis problemas diarios. Esa pared en la esquina es mi solución de problemas: el espacio aireado me llena de alegría cada vez que voy a hacer ejercicio de respiración, murmuro algunas oraciones y dejo mis preocupaciones".

Del mismo modo, cada día de nuestra vida tiene sus propios problemas. En la primera lectura, mientras realizaba su trabajo asignado por Dios, Amós encontró cierta resistencia de Jeroboam, un líder corrupto, y Amasías, un sumo sacerdote leal al rey. Jeroboam consideraba a Amós como nada más que un profeta de la corte que buscaba ganarse la vida presumiendo hablar en nombre de Dios. Amós no permitió que esta falsa acusación lo desmoralizara, sino que se la quitó del hombro.

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús envió a sus discípulos en su primera práctica de predicación a las aldeas. Pensó que era prudente ofrecerles un gesto de resistencia a los problemas cuando dijo: "Si algún lugar no los recibe con agrado o se niega a escucharlos, sacúndanse el polvo de los pies" (Mc 6, 11). En otras palabras, si tratas de enseñar a la gente y encuentras un fracaso como resultado de su oposición, no dejes que el fracaso te desanime. Sacuda el polvo de esa aldea, vaya a una nueva aldea y comience de nuevo en una página nueva.

El miedo al resultado de nuestros esfuerzos siempre ha sido una cosa importante que nos ha impedido hacer algunos movimientos en la vida. A veces nos detenemos demasiado en los fracasos pasados y permitimos que nos roben la vida de entusiasmo y alegría. Otras veces permitimos que las presiones del lugar de trabajo arruinen la paz de nuestra vida familiar. Del mismo modo, una de las cosas que obstaculiza la difusión del Evangelio no son solo las excusas de la gente por su falta de buen conocimiento de la teología para predicar, sino el miedo al rechazo o lo que la gente va a decir.

Para evitar las excusas y el miedo, debemos enfrentar nuestras experiencias y aprender a sacudirnos el polvo de los problemas del día. Sacudir el polvo de los pies de los discípulos es su propia manera de colgar sus problemas en el pasado y no dejar que el recuerdo de los malos tratos se interponga en el camino del éxito futuro. Esto se hace con la esperanza de que mañana traiga consigo un nuevo día con nuevas oportunidades. En este caso, es como un partido de fútbol. Incluso si perdiste 10-0 en el juego de ayer, hoy es un juego de pelota completamente nuevo y el marcador comienza en 0-0.

La buena noticia hoy es que el fracaso no es el fin del mundo. Deberíamos esperarlo, y cuando sucede, ejercemos el ritual de Jesús para el fracaso: "sacudirnos el polvo" y continuar. Lo que sucede cuando no conseguimos sacudirnos el polvo de los fallos de los pies es que el polvo se acumula y nos pesa. El resultado entonces es depresión, retramiento, aburrimiento, ira, confusión, señalar con el dedo, consternación y desesperación. Cuando esto sucede, renunciamos en lugar de ir a una nueva ciudad como se les instruyó a los discípulos oa un nuevo proyecto o nueva visión. Pero Jesús no quiere que seamos desamparados. Él quiere que comencemos de nuevo cada nuevo día con nuevas oportunidades y nuevo celo.

Jesús ya nos ha proporcionado un solucionador de problemas en sí mismo. Esto es lo que Pedro quiso decir cuando dijo a los creyentes: "Echen sobre él toda su ansiedad, porque él se preocupa por ustedes" (1 Pedro 5: 7). Aprovechemos, por tanto, de esta terapia divina cada vez que encontraremos resistencia, fracaso o rechazo.



## RE-OPENING GUIDELINES FOR PARISH OFFICES AND MINISTRIES

I am happy to inform that the Diocese of San Bernardino re-opens effective July 6, 2021, all parish offices, parish ministries and related programs/activities may reopen fully, operating under guidelines contained herein. The following changes will be implemented immediately by any group wishing to begin praying in any of the Church facilities in our parish.

### Changes to Capacity/Social Distancing Regulations

1. Seating for Ministry worship, events/activities held within parish church should be spaced at three (3) feet.
2. Seating for ministry events/activities held within parish church, hall, school classrooms, meeting rooms, etc should be spaced at three (3) feet.
3. When reserving rooms for meetings/ministry activities, attendance numbers should be considered.

### Changes to Sanitizing/Hygiene Protocols

1. "Deep" cleaning before and after each service is no longer necessary.
2. Each group is to sanitize seating at the conclusion of regularly scheduled service.

### Changes to Mask Requirement

1. Masks are no longer required, indoors, for vaccinated persons. *Parishioners are encouraged to wear masks, if health conditions exist, or as a personal choice, to ensure maximum safety/precautions for all.*

### Ministry Meetings/Workshops/Trainings

2. Ministry programs may hold pre-scheduled meetings within meeting rooms, if and only if the three (3) feet social distancing can be maintained.
3. Whenever possible, ZOOM meetings are strongly preferred.
4. No *indoor* parish-wide workshops, training sessions or concerts – where registration is open to the larger community are not permitted at this time.
5. **Outdoor** workshops, concerts or training sessions with such 'open registration' are permitted, subject to the three (3) feet spacing for seating.

### Hospitality/Social gatherings within Ministries

1. Pre-packaged/boxed hospitality is preferred.
2. Catered/served lunches are permitted; servers/caterers must wear masks and gloves when filling plates and serving those in buffet lines.
3. No self-serve buffets are permitted; potlucks are permitted, if one person assembles plates and serves attendees; masks and gloves must be worn by server, whether serving indoors or outdoors.
4. No masks are required outdoors by attendees at such events.
5. Three (3) feet social distance seating for these events is required, both indoors and outdoors.

### Praying and holding hands

1. Refrain from holding hands with other members when saying any prayer.
2. Greetings will be expressed among members without any physical contact or touching.
3. Kissing/touching of Sacred Objects/Statues not permitted in a prayer meeting.

### Other Recommendations

1. Singing by Cantors/Choirs: No restrictions
2. Singing by Assembly: No restrictions
3. No open flames outdoors, at any time.
4. If money is to be collected, the collector should wear mask and glove.
5. In all this, **vaccination** is highly recommended for members to freely pray and sing together.

## PAUTAS DE REAPERTURA PARA LAS OFICINAS Y MINISTERIOS PARROQUIALES

Me complace informar que la Diócesis de San Bernardino reabre a partir del 6 de julio de 2021, todas las oficinas parroquiales, ministerios parroquiales y programas / actividades relacionados pueden reabrir completamente, operando bajo las pautas contenidas en este documento. Los siguientes cambios serán implementados inmediatamente por cualquier grupo que desee comenzar a orar en cualquiera de las instalaciones de la Iglesia en nuestra parroquia.

### Cambios en las regulaciones de capacidad / distanciamiento social

1. Los asientos para la adoración del Ministerio, los eventos / actividades que se llevan a cabo dentro de la iglesia parroquial deben estar espaciados a tres (3) pies.
2. Los asientos para eventos / actividades ministeriales que se llevan a cabo dentro de la iglesia parroquial, el salón, salones de la escuela, las salas de reuniones, etc. deben tener un espacio de tres (3) pies.
3. Al reservar salón para reuniones / actividades ministeriales, se debe considerar el número de asistentes.

### Cambios en los protocolos de higiene / desinfección

1. Ya no es necesaria una limpieza "profunda" antes y después de cada servicio.
2. Cada grupo debe desinfectar los asientos al finalizar el servicio programado regularmente.

### Cambios en el requisito de la máscara

1. Ya no se requieren máscaras, en interiores, para las personas vacunadas. Se anima a los feligreses a usar máscaras, si existen condiciones de salud, o como una elección personal, para garantizar la máxima seguridad / precauciones para todos.

### Reuniones / talleres / capacitaciones ministeriales

2. Los programas del ministerio pueden llevar a cabo reuniones pre-programadas dentro de las salas de reuniones, si y solo si se puede mantener el distanciamiento social de tres (3) pies.
3. Siempre que sea posible, se prefieren las reuniones ZOOM.
4. No se permiten talleres, sesiones de capacitación o conciertos en el interior de toda la parroquia, donde la inscripción está abierta a la comunidad en general, no están permitidos en este momento.
5. Se permiten talleres al aire libre, conciertos o sesiones de capacitación con tal "registro abierto", sujeto al espacio de tres (3) pies para los asistentes.

### Hospitalidad / reuniones sociales dentro de los ministerios

1. Se prefiere la hospitalidad empaquetada / en caja.
2. Se permiten almuerzos atendidos / servidos; los meseros / proveedores de catering deben usar máscaras y guantes al llenar los platos y servirlos en las filas del buffet.
3. No se permiten bufés de autoservicio; se permiten comidas compartidas, si una persona prepara platos y sirve a los asistentes; El servidor debe usar máscaras y guantes, ya sea que sirva en el interior o al aire libre.
4. Los asistentes a tales eventos no requieren máscaras al aire libre.
5. Se requieren asientos a una distancia social de tres (3) pies para estos eventos, tanto en el interior como en el exterior.

### Rezando y tomados de la mano

1. Abstente de tomarse de la mano de otros miembros cuando digas cualquier oración.
2. Los saludos se expresarán entre los miembros sin ningún contacto físico o contacto.
3. Besar / tocar objetos sagrados / estatuas no está permitido en una reunión de oración.

### Otras recomendaciones

1. Canto de cantantes / coros: sin restricciones
2. Canto por asamblea: sin restricciones
3. No hay llamas abiertas al aire libre, en ningún momento.
4. Si se va a recolectar dinero, el recolector debe usar máscara y guantes.
5. En todo esto, la **vacunación** es muy recomendable para que los miembros recen libremente y canten juntos.

### Re-Opening Guidelines for Worship

Effective June 19, 2021, all parishes within the Diocese of San Bernardino may operate under the sacramental/liturgical/worship guidelines contained as follows:

1. Vaccinated persons may not wear masks in Church.
2. Ushers/volunteers/extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist are strongly encouraged to wear masks when serving.
3. Those serving Communion may now say: "The Body of Christ" to each communicant who then responds, "Amen."
4. Altar Servers can resume – no restriction.
5. Bulletins: No restrictions
6. Hospitality: No self-help; servers continue to wear masks and gloves.
7. Physical Distance: Three (3) feet separation recommended.
8. Offertory: No restrictions
9. Our Father Recitation: Refrain from holding hands with the other person.
10. Private Prayer/Devotion: No restrictions
11. Recessional: No restrictions
12. Sign of Peace: Permitted without any physical contract or touching.
13. Singing by Cantors: No restrictions
14. Singing by Choirs: No restrictions
15. Singing by Assembly: No restrictions
16. Visits to Homebound: Permitted
17. Votive Candles: No restrictions
18. Weddings: No restrictions

Given these relaxed re-opening standards, it is of critical importance that when any parishioner or parishioners are ill, or if a member of their household is ill that such a person or persons should remain at home, and not come to any Church celebrations until they become well. This is to be taken seriously as the pandemic continues to threaten certain communities within Riverside and San Bernardino counties.


