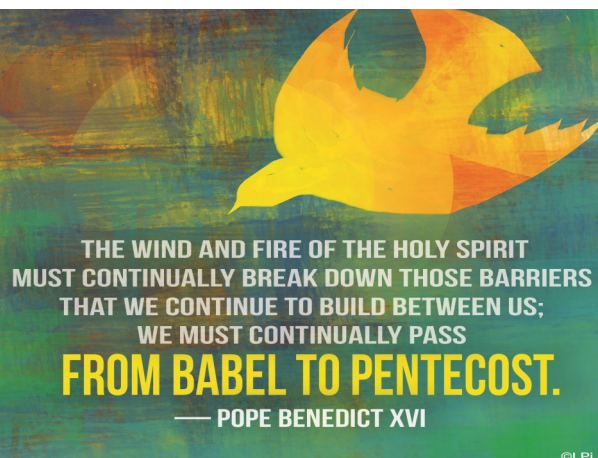

PENTECOST SUNDAY

THE BREATH OF PENTECOST

Today we celebrate the anniversary of the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and the Church. This marks the definitive end of the 50 days of the season of Easter. In the first reading, Luke paints a vivid picture of the first Pentecost. According to him, the Church of one faith in one Lord, the Church united by Christ into one body, takes its birth from the Pentecost experience of a driving wind and breathtaking words of hope. In so doing he establishes that the Church carries out its mission in the power of the Spirit – the very breath of God!

Paul tells us in the second reading that it takes the Holy Spirit for anyone to say that Jesus is Lord. In other words, it takes a life controlled by the Spirit and lived in total surrender to show that Jesus is truly Lord. Today's Gospel for Pentecost Sunday comes from John and is often referred to as the "Johannine Pentecost." It is quite different from the familiar Pentecost story of Acts 2:1-13. While the Acts of the Apostles speak of the experience of the Early Church on the day of Pentecost, the Gospel passage teaches the actual appearance of the Risen Lord to the disciples and their commission confirmed by the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Breathed with power from on high, the disciples are now set to carry on his work. The work of Jesus is to reveal the identity of God, which he himself has done through signs and miracles. This reminds us about Genesis 2:7, where God breathed the breath of life into the first human, Adam, and he became a living being. In like manner, the disciples have now been given a new life through the breath and gift of the Holy Spirit to reveal the identity of God.

The good news is that the divine breath is not only life-giving, but power filled. To receive the Holy Spirit is to be animated with divine power. He can never be received without a realization of the power of his presence, a power which enables the human person to do extraordinary things. When this power of the Spirit of God came upon the Apostles, they spoke in tongues, preached the Good News without fear and continued the healing ministry of Christ.

In a world where almost, everyone is suffering from exhaustion from anxiety, internal and external strife, fear of the unknown, hunger from scarcity of food, suffocation from the masks against coronavirus, a new lease of the breath of the Spirit is urgently needed for real life and peace. Jesus came to the upper room when the world of the Apostles collapsed. He knew that the greatest thing they needed was inner peace. He breathed on them the breath of his peace. Just as the circumstances of the Apostles called for divine peace, our prevailing situation calls for new breath of Pentecost to enable us grapple with the challenges facing us.

So, today, as we celebrate the divine breath and life-force of God this Pentecost Sunday, let us open our hearts for a fresh release of divine power. Breath is life, and the breath of the Spirit is life-giving oxygen. We all have this life-giving and empowering breath of God in us but not all of us have realized the power. It is one thing to receive the *breath* of the Spirit and another thing to allow it to fill us up and permeate our whole life and personality. Let us sing for this infilling with Edwin Hatch: "Breathe on me, breadth of God, fill me with life anew, that I may love as you have loved and do as you would do." So, let us let in the breath of the Holy Spirit, breathe it in and let it fill us, and inspire us, and give us new life, joy, and peace.

EL ALIENTO DEL PENTECOSTÉS

Hoy celebramos el aniversario del descenso del Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles y la Iglesia. Esto marca el final definitivo de los 50 días de la temporada de Pascua. En la primera lectura, Lucas pinta un cuadro vívido del primer Pentecostés. Según él, la Iglesia de una fe en un Señor, la Iglesia unida por Cristo en un solo cuerpo, nace de la experiencia de Pentecostés de un viento que sopla y de impresionantes palabras de esperanza. Al hacerlo, afirma que la Iglesia lleva a cabo su misión en el poder del Espíritu, ¡el mismo aliento de Dios!

Pablo nos dice en la segunda lectura que se necesita el Espíritu Santo para que alguien diga que Jesús es el Señor. En otras palabras, se necesita una vida controlada por el Espíritu y vivida en total entrega para demostrar que Jesús es verdaderamente el Señor. El Evangelio de hoy para el domingo de Pentecostés proviene de Juan y a menudo se lo conoce como el "Pentecostés de Juan". Es bastante diferente de la conocida historia de Pentecostés de Hechos 2: 1-13. Mientras que los Hechos de los Apóstoles hablan de la experiencia de la Iglesia Primitiva el día de Pentecostés, el pasaje del Evangelio enseña la aparición real del Señor Resucitado a los discípulos y su comisión confirmada por el don del Espíritu Santo.

Respirados con poder de lo alto, los discípulos están ahora preparados para continuar con su obra. La obra de Jesús es revelar la identidad de Dios, lo que él mismo ha hecho a través de señales y milagros. Esto nos recuerda a Génesis 2: 7, donde Dios soplo el aliento de vida en el primer ser humano, Adán, y se convirtió en un ser vivo. De la misma manera, a los discípulos ahora se les ha dado una nueva vida a través del sople y el don del Espíritu Santo para revelar la identidad de Dios.

La buena noticia es que el aliento divino no solo da vida, sino que está lleno de poder. Recibir el Espíritu Santo es estar animado por el poder divino. Nunca podrá ser recibido sin darse cuenta del poder de su presencia, un poder que permite a la persona humana hacer cosas extraordinarias. Cuando este poder del Espíritu de Dios vino sobre los Apóstoles, hablaron en lenguas, predicaron las Buenas Noticias sin temor y continuaron el ministerio de sanidad de Cristo.

En un mundo donde casi todo el mundo sufre de agotamiento por ansiedad, luchas internas y externas, miedo a lo desconocido, hambre por escasez de alimentos, asfixia por las máscaras contra el coronavirus, se necesita urgentemente una nueva respiración del Espíritu para vida real y paz. Jesús llegó al aposento alto cuando el mundo de los apóstoles se derrumbó. Sabía que lo más grande que necesitaban era paz interior. Soplo sobre ellos el aliento de su paz. Así como las circunstancias de los Apóstoles exigieron la paz divina, nuestra situación imperante exige un nuevo aliento de Pentecostés que nos permita lidiar con los desafíos que enfrentamos.

Entonces, hoy, mientras celebramos el aliento divino y la fuerza vital de Dios este domingo de Pentecostés, abramos nuestros corazones para una nueva liberación del poder divino. El aliento es vida y el aliento del Espíritu es oxígeno vivificante. Todos tenemos este sople de Dios vivificante y empoderador en nosotros, pero no todos nos hemos dado cuenta del poder. Una cosa es recibir el *aliento* del Espíritu y otra cosa es permitir que nos llene e impregne toda nuestra vida y personalidad. Cantemos por esta llenura con Edwin Hatch: "Soplo en mí, amplitud de Dios, lléname de vida de nuevo, para que pueda amar como tú has amado y hacer lo que tú harías". Entonces, dejemos entrar el sople del Espíritu Santo, inhalemos y dejemos que nos llene, nos inspire y nos dé nueva vida, gozo y paz.
