Homily Reflection by Fr. Imo

REMAIN IN MY LOVE

This Sunday the Church continues John's discourse on the relationship between the Lord and believers which we started last weekend. The emphasis this time is on the love that binds this relationship and how it endures over the time. In this passage, Jesus says that as his Father loves is how he loves. The love Jesus is talking about is divine. It first exists between him and his Father. *As the father has loved me, so have I loved you.*" God, the Creator, cannot but love because it is in his nature to love. In his love for the world living in sin, he gives Jesus his only begotten son to pay the price for sin to save the world (Jn 3:16).

Jesus too wants the disciples to love as he loves. How does Jesus love? Jesus is the love of God who came down from heaven (Jn 3:16). He is the love of God made manifest. In Jesus we see the love of God in practice. It is love and compassion that motivated his preaching, his charity and his miracles, throughout his ministry.

This love of Jesus is sacrificial and unconditional. He spent himself doing good for the people and always put his life on the line for his friends. Motivated by love, Jesus offered himself to be sacrificed for the salvation of the world. This way of loving tells us that true love does not count the cost involved in relationship.

Jesus loves his disciples as friends, not as a Lord. To show this heavenly side of his love, Jesus addressed his disciples as friends. I am no longer calling you servants because servants do not understand what their master is thinking and planning. I have called you friends because I have let you in on everything I have heard from the Father (Jn 15:15). There is no gainsaying that Jesus loves us with the love of the Father. The challenge now is how can we remain in his love?

One way of remaining in his love is by feeding on his words and commandments. Jesus expects fidelity to the commandments (John 15:10), the fruitfulness of responsible service (v. 16) and a mutual symbiotic love for one another in his name (vv. 12, 17). It is in keeping his commandments that we demonstrate our love, obedience, respect and gratitude for his love for us. In allowing the Word of Jesus to remain alive in our hearts, we become rooted firmly in him.

We remain in his love by loving others, not as we love ourselves (Lev. 19:18) but as Jesus loves us. "Love your neighbor as I have loved you" (Jn 13:34). In this revolutionized way of loving by Jesus, while the command is still about the love of the neighbor, the motive behind it is different. Jesus' love is now the paradigm to measure true love for others and not that of the human person which is exercised as a person thinks, feels or wants.

This love goes beyond sentimental love in a world where the true meaning of love is lost to selfish interest, compromise, or favoritism. Jesus bases his call to this universal love on God's behavior. God blesses the good and the bad alike. He makes his sun rise on the bad and the good and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust (Mt 5:45).

This invitation challenges the exuberance of those of us who make promises when the journey is fresh but fail when the going becomes difficult. Jesus wants sincere disciples whose love will withstand the tides of times and seasons. Those who respond to faith with great zeal but wane down with the passage of time do not last long. So, it is not enough to love and be loved, to believe and be baptized but to remain faithful, dedicated, and loving in the face of challenges and temptations.

PERMANECE EN MI AMOR

Este domingo la Iglesia continúa el discurso de Juan sobre la relación entre el Señor y los creyentes que comenzamos el fin de semana pasado. El énfasis esta vez está en el amor que une esta relación y cómo perdura a lo largo del tiempo. En este pasaje, Jesús dice que como ama su Padre es como ama. El amor del que habla Jesús es divino. Primero existe entre él y su Padre. *Como el padre me ha amado, también yo te he amado a ti*". Dios, el Creador, no puede dejar de amar porque está en su naturaleza amar. En su amor por el mundo que vive en pecado, le da a Jesús su único hijo para que pague el precio del pecado para salvar al mundo (Jn 3:16).

Jesús también quiere que los discípulos amen como él ama. ¿Cómo ama Jesús? Jesús es el amor de Dios que bajó del cielo (Jn 3:16). Él es el amor de Dios manifestado. En Jesús vemos el amor de Dios en la práctica. Es el amor y la compasión lo que motivó su predicación, su caridad y sus milagros, a lo largo de su ministerio.

Este amor de Jesús es sacrificado e incondicional. Se dedicó a hacer el bien a la gente y siempre arriesgó su vida por sus amigos. Motivado por el amor, Jesús se ofreció a ser sacrificado por la salvación del mundo. Esta forma de amar nos dice que el verdadero amor no cuenta el costo involucrado en la relación.

Jesús ama a sus discípulos como amigos, no como un Señor. Para mostrar este lado celestial de su amor, Jesús se dirigió a sus discípulos como amigos. Ya no los llamo sirvientes porque los sirvientes no entienden lo que su amo está pensando y planeando. Los he llamado amigos porque les he contado todo lo que he oído del Padre (Jn 15,15). No se puede negar que Jesús nos ama con el amor del Padre. El desafío ahora es ¿cómo podemos permanecer en su amor?

Una forma de permanecer en su amor es alimentándose de sus palabras y mandamientos. Jesús espera fidelidad a los mandamientos (Juan 15:10), la fecundidad del servicio responsable (v. 16) y un amor simbiótico mutuo unos por otros en su nombre (vv. 12, 17). Es al guardar sus mandamientos que demostramos nuestro amor, obediencia, respeto y gratitud por su amor por nosotros. Al permitir que la Palabra de Jesús permanezca viva en nuestros corazones, nos arraigamos firmemente en él.

Permanecemos en su amor al amar a los demás, no como nos amamos a nosotros mismos (Lev. 19:18), sino como Jesús nos ama. "Ama a tu prójimo como yo te he amado" (Jn 13, 34). En esta forma revolucionaria de amar de Jesús, mientras el mandamiento sigue siendo sobre el amor al prójimo, el motivo detrás de él es diferente. El amor de Jesús es ahora el paradigma para medir el verdadero amor por los demás y no el de la persona humana que se ejerce como una persona piensa, siente o quiere.

Este amor va más allá del amor sentimental en un mundo donde el verdadero significado del amor se pierde ante el interés egoísta, el compromiso o el favoritismo. Jesús basa su llamado a este amor universal en el comportamiento de Dios. Dios bendice a los buenos y a los malos por igual. Hace salir el sol sobre malos y buenos y hace llover sobre justos e injustos (Mt 5, 45).

Esta invitación desafía la exuberancia de aquellos de nosotros que hacemos promesas cuando el viaje es nuevo, pero fracasamos cuando el camino se vuelve difícil. Jesús quiere discípulos sinceros cuyo amor resistirá las mareas de los tiempos y las estaciones. Aquellos que responden a la fe con gran celo pero se debilitan con el paso del tiempo no duran mucho. Entonces, no es suficiente amar y ser amado, creer y ser bautizado, sino permanecer fiel, dedicado y amar frente a los desafíos y tentaciones.

Parish Maintenance Report

- Acts of vandalism on Rialto center: unfortunately we have had two break-ins in our Rialto site the past weeks, please help us to report any suspicious persons or activities after office hours at our Rialto church premises by calling the Rialto Police department. In the past months we have replaced a total of 5 broken windows and we have installed a fence around the new image of our Lady of Immaculate Conception prayer garden to avoid acts of vandalism to the statue like happened with the previous image.
- Weed abatement & Tree Trimming: Weed abatement has been performed at the Rialto Church premises and at backyard of the Priest house for the spring season, pending to do is the trimming of the trees at the Resurrection Academy that have sprouted vigorously this year, trimming of these trees will be scheduled soon to avoid any hazards.

- Actos de vandalismo en el centro de Rialto: lamentablemente hemos tenido dos robos en nuestro sitio de Rialto las últimas semanas, ayúdenos a informar sobre cualquier persona o actividad sospechosa fuera del horario de oficina en las instalaciones de nuestra iglesia de Rialto llamando al departamento de policía de Rialto. En los últimos meses hemos reemplazado un total de 5 ventanas rotas y hemos instalado una cerca alrededor de la nueva imagen del jardín de oración de Nuestra Señora de la Inmaculada Concepción para evitar actos vandálicos a la estatua como sucedió con la imagen anterior.
- Eliminación de malezas y poda de árboles: La eliminación de malezas se ha realizado en las instalaciones de la Iglesia de Rialto y en el patio trasero de la casa del sacerdote para la temporada de primavera, queda pendiente la poda de los árboles en la Academia Resurrección que han brotado vigorosamente este año, poda de estos árboles se programarán pronto para evitar cualquier peligro.




