





Homily Reflection by Fr. Imo

WE ARE HEIRS OF GOD ALMIGHTY

Our readings for this solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity presents the Trinity less as a doctrine and more as a fact of God's deepening personal relationship with us. In the first reading, Moses marvels at God's initiative and intimacy. For Paul, in the second reading, the Spirit of adoption infinitely deepens that intimacy. The Deuteronomy's "Lord your God" becomes in the second reading our "Abba, Father," and we, "children, heirs of God, and joint heirs with Christ." The Gospel assures us of God's continued presence of being with us in all our experiences till the end of the earth. The emphasis on these readings is on us – what kind of people are we ought to be as those created to mirror God and worship him.

Like the Jews of the time of Moses, we too have with the Holy Trinity been blessed by being created in the image of God, redeemed by Jesus who feeds us daily with the Eucharist, blessed with the Holy Spirit who is our advocate and sanctifier. We are called to experience the exalted status of being sons and daughters of God. As heirs, then, we have the right of inheritance of God's riches as brothers and sisters of Jesus, who made it available at his own expense. As partakers of the divine grace of the Trinity, therefore, we are privileged to participate in the dignity that belongs to the Holy Trinity. If we are thus surrounded by the protective love of the Trinity, we are bound to honor God in our bodies by a holy life.

This mystery of participating in the Trinity extends to our relationship with one another as brothers and sisters in one God. Jesus does not only redeem us to live in the divine kingdom, but he also unites us with God in a community of love. As brothers and sisters in the Trinity, we are called to build a community and to share what we have with one another. The description of God in Exodus as merciful, gracious, slow to anger, loving and faithful, should characterize our life and relationship with our neighbors because Jesus once said: "Be perfect even as your heavenly father is perfect".

Our participation in the Trinity reminds us that our hearts are God's own playground where he reveals Himself in and through Christ, by the work of the Holy Spirit. If we thus embody godliness in our nature, we have potential for love and mercy that are very much lacking today. For this reason, the Church is asking us today to use our godly love and mercy to check the spread of heartless wickedness which shows itself in divisiveness, unforgiveness, party spirit, gossips, racial discriminations, different forms of abuse, and the like. Let the thought that we share in the dignity that belongs to the Trinity help us to avoid the sins against charity.

Today, we rejoice, that created after the image of God, redeemed from sin in Jesus Christ the Son, and adopted as sons and daughters through the Holy Spirit, we have become heirs of the Father, and joint heirs with Jesus, the Son. We are now the people of his kingdom. We are a family, we are one. As we continue to share in the wisdom, power and presence of Jesus who is with us always till the end of time, we are forever indwelt by the Spirit of God who puts that power to work in our lives.

So, as we hear God's holy word proclaimed today, let us reflect on all that God has done to make us his own. Our next task is to allow these unmerited blessings and our exalted status to provoke hope in us. This way we live in hope that is not vague, in a hope that gives certainty and courage to face the future with the full assurance that our God, the Holy Trinity, has our backs.

SOMOS HEREDEROS DE DIOS TODOPODERO

Nuestras lecturas para esta solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad presentan la Trinidad menos como una doctrina y más como un hecho de la relación personal cada vez más profunda de Dios con nosotros. En la primera lectura, Moisés se maravilla ante la iniciativa y la intimidad de Dios. Para Pablo, en la segunda lectura, el Espíritu de adopción profundiza infinitamente esa intimidad. El "Señor tu Dios" del Deuteronomio se convierte en la segunda lectura en nuestro "Abba, Padre" y nosotros, "hijos, herederos de Dios y coherederos con Cristo". El Evangelio nos asegura la presencia continua de Dios de estar con nosotros en todas nuestras experiencias hasta el fin de la tierra. El énfasis en estas lecturas está en nosotros: qué tipo de personas debemos ser como aquellos creados para reflejar a Dios y adorarlo.

Como los judíos de la época de Moisés, también nosotros con la Santísima Trinidad hemos sido bendecidos al ser creados a imagen de Dios, redimidos por Jesús que nos alimenta diariamente con la Eucaristía, bendecidos con el Espíritu Santo que es nuestro abogado y santificador. Estamos llamados a experimentar el estado exaltado de ser hijos e hijas de Dios. Como herederos, entonces, tenemos el derecho de heredar las riquezas de Dios como hermanos y hermanas de Jesús, quien las hizo disponibles a sus expensas. Como participantes de la gracia divina de la Trinidad, por lo tanto, tenemos el privilegio de participar de la dignidad que pertenece a la Santísima Trinidad. Si estamos así rodeados por el amor protector de la Trinidad, estamos obligados a honrar a Dios en nuestros cuerpos con una vida santa.

Este misterio de participar en la Trinidad se extiende a nuestra relación unos con otros como hermanos y hermanas en un solo Dios. Jesús no solo nos redime para vivir en el reino divino, sino que también nos une con Dios en una comunidad de amor. Como hermanos y hermanas de la Trinidad, estamos llamados a construir una comunidad y a compartir lo que tenemos unos con otros. La descripción de Dios en Éxodo como misericordioso, misericordioso, lento para la ira, amoroso y fiel, debería caracterizar nuestra vida y relación con nuestro prójimo porque Jesús dijo una vez: "Sed perfectos como es perfecto vuestro Padre celestial".

Nuestra participación en la Trinidad nos recuerda que nuestro corazón es el patio de recreo de Dios, donde Él se revela a Sí mismo en Cristo y por medio de la obra del Espíritu Santo. Si encarnamos la piedad en nuestra naturaleza, tendremos potencial para el amor y la misericordia que hoy faltan mucho. Por esta razón, la Iglesia nos pide hoy que usemos nuestro amor piadoso y misericordia para controlar la propagación de la maldad sin corazón que se manifiesta en divisiones, falta de perdón, espíritu de fiesta, chismes, discriminación racial, diferentes formas de abuso y cosas por el estilo. Que el pensamiento de compartir la dignidad de la Trinidad nos ayude a evitar los pecados contra la caridad.

Hoy, nos alegramos de que, creados a imagen de Dios, redimidos del pecado en Jesucristo el Hijo y adoptados como hijos e hijas por el Espíritu Santo, nos hemos convertido en herederos del Padre y coherederos con Jesús, el Hijo. Ahora somos el pueblo de su reino. Somos una familia, somos uno. A medida que continuamos compartiendo la sabiduría, el poder y la presencia de Jesús, quien siempre está con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos, el Espíritu de Dios mora para siempre en nosotros, quien pone ese poder a trabajar en nuestras vidas.

Entonces, al escuchar la santa palabra de Dios proclamada hoy, reflexionemos sobre todo lo que Dios ha hecho para hacernos tuyos. Nuestra próxima tarea es permitir que estas bendiciones inmerecidas y nuestro estado exaltado provoquen esperanza en nosotros. Así vivimos en una esperanza que no es vaga, en una esperanza que da certeza y coraje para afrontar el futuro con la plena seguridad de que nuestro Dios, la Santísima Trinidad, nos respalda.


